Built on a bluff overlooking the Susquehanna River, Fort Hunter Mansion and Park has served as a war fort, a hub for frontier commerce, and an exclusive private estate. Now preserved and open to the public, Fort Hunter Mansion and Park invites you to explore Pennsylvania's rich history. Tour the fort decorated for Christmas and view other displays, a train layout, and gift shop.

Our last stop on this trip will be to drive through the **Hershey Sweet Lights** display. 600 illuminated, animated light displays decorate two miles of fields and wooded trails.
