Wednesday, September 15, 2021 is your opportunity to travel with us to the historic Laurel Hills Cemetery, Philadelphia, PA and The Highland Mansion and Gardens, Fort Washington, PA.

Laurel Hill Cemetery was established in 1836. It is one of the few cemeteries in the nation to be honored with the designation of National Historic Landmark. We will have a guided tour of the historic cemetery, with our guide pointing out many points of interest which include a beautiful view of the Schuylkill River.



The Highlands Mansion and Gardens is a 44-acre historic

treasure with a late 18th century Georgian mansion and two acres of formal gardens. Surrounded by massive stone walls, the gardens offer a beautiful example of early 20th century estate gardening with an unusual blend of horticulture and architecture. The site features nine outbuildings, including a bank barn, springhouse, greenhouse, smokehouse, and Gothic Revival gardener's cottage. Lunch will be provided at Highlands Mansion.
